Supt. Froebe reported on the following: We held our annual custodians meeting earlier this month in preparation for our summer cleaning and maintenance of the buildings. Central appears to be the only challenge as they work around the geothermal installation. TCI informed me they are finished with the borefield behind Central. They plan to leave the fence up at least through the end of June to help keep people from walking across the freshly planted grass seed. Roofing Associates plan to get started on the new roof at Adams as soon as school is out. They will be coordinating their efforts with Lincoln Heating and Cooling who will be installing the new HVAC units. The 5th Grade Civil War Walk hosted at the Lincoln Heritage Museum was a success. We are extremely thankful the museum was able to stay open after Lincoln College closed. Teacher Appreciation week was celebrated across the district last week. We continue to be extremely fortunate to have such high-quality faculty and staff working in our schools. We received our most recent sales tax payment for the month of February in the amount of \$52,092.35. Logan County Superintendents continue to hold meetings with Regional Superintendent Mark Jontry regarding an alternative school for Logan County. 8th Grade Graduation is set for next week Wednesday, May 24th at 3:00.
